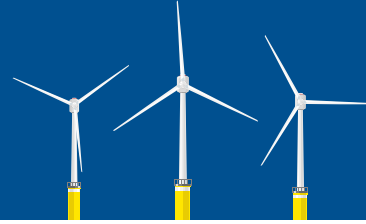
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Coastal Virginia Offshore Wind (CVOW) Underground Construction Updates



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In 2024, Dominion Energy reached several milestones for underground construction at the State Military Reservation (SMR).

- All nine Direct Pipes (DPs) were installed at the Rifle Range.
- All Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) was completed under Lake Christine and General Booth Boulevard/Lake Rudee. Pipe bundles were installed inside the HDD pipes.
- All Duct Bank was installed.
- All nine underground conduit connections were installed across the Rifle Range.
- Four (of nine) vaults in the Transition Joint Bay (TJB) were installed and fully connected to the DPs.

In winter and spring 2025, we will:

- Complete vaults five through nine in the TJB and connect to the DPs. Temporary shoring will be installed for the final 80 feet of underground conduit connections, and will be removed after TJB completion.
- Begin cable installation inside the underground conduit, connecting the offshore export cables to the onshore export cables to Harpers Switching Station.
- Begin restoration of the Rifle Range to return it to a grass field.
- Complete manhole connections at SMR.
- As a reminder, there will be a pause in construction in spring for military exercises at SMR.

Most onshore construction activities, such as excavating and pouring concrete, will occur during the day. When necessary, some overnight tasks will continue with reduced overnight lighting. When temporary shoring is installed, the closest neighbors may hear the metal moving. Shoring activities will happen for up to two weeks in January 2025, up to one week in February 2025, and up to one week in March 2025. Underground construction at SMR is on schedule to finish by early summer 2025. CVOW will continue onshore and offshore construction activities in 2025 and is on time and on budget for completion by the end of 2026.

Thank you to everyone who has provided us feedback. We are committed to continuously improving our construction processes and addressing any concerns.
