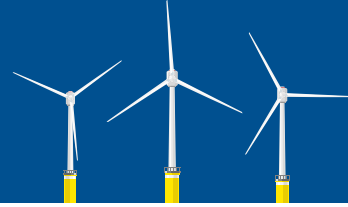

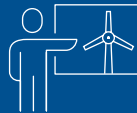

In July, Dominion Energy achieved several milestones for underground construction at the State Military Reservation (SMR). All nine Direct Pipes (DPs) are now installed at the Rifle Range. All Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) is complete under General Booth Boulevard/Lake Rudee. Pile driving for the foundation of the Transition Joint Bay (TJB) finished in early August.

Now that these tasks are complete, most onshore construction activities will occur during the day. Some low-noise overnight tasks will continue when necessary, and overnight lighting will be reduced unless needed. During day shift, we will connect the nine DPs to the nine TJB vaults by temporarily installing sheet piles and excavating the conduit path. Construction inside the TJB, such as forming and pouring concrete, will continue. Pipe bundles that house cables and fiber will continue to be installed inside the HDD pipes at both sites (Lake Christine and General Booth Boulevard/Lake Rudee).

Thank you to everyone who has provided us feedback. We are committed to continuously improving our construction processes and addressing any concerns. If you are interested in learning more about the remaining work at SMR or have questions about the underground construction activities, we invite you to our next Croatan community meeting. We hope to see you there.
